



Log Truck Driver

Lone Rock Resources has an opening for Truck Driver. The successful candidate will perform in a production setting as a Class A CDL driver. Lone Rock is a family owned timber management and logging company with a proud past and a bright future. Lone Rock's Trucking Department provides various transportation services to many departments within the company. We are in search of a career-oriented driver who wants to join an existing team of professionals.

JOB DESCRIPTION: *This is a permanent, full-time, hourly position.*

This job primarily requires driving 7 axle short log truck as well as 6 axle long log truck for the company's logging sides. Other duties may be assigned at times hauling for other contract loggers in southern Oregon. Annual mileage driven range from 50,000 to 70,000 miles. Work schedules vary and are reflective of the duties being performed. General work days are Monday through Friday with limited weekend requirements. Average hours per week are 60, with occasional dips to 40 and peaks to 70. Daily schedule varies, requiring some early start times as well as late evening ending times. Other miscellaneous duties may be assigned as needed.

GENERAL JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- Class A CDL License with tank endorsement
- Capable of safely hauling gross loads of up to 105,500 lbs.
- Acceptable driving history required as it relates to moving violations and drug/alcohol screening.
- Must have a minimum of 1-year CDL log hauling on forest roads within the Pacific Northwest.
- Prior experience with short logger is not required but preference will be given.
- Willingness to work variable and changing schedules as job duties may require; typically 12 hours per day, 5 days per week but may sparingly require 7 days straight.
- A proven general understanding of driver's hours of service rules as they apply to Intrastate and short haul exemption hauling.
- Ability to learn electronic logging devices (ELD) in the truck for tracking daily trip records and time
- Willing to work in a safe manner and adhere to general company safety policies as well as State & Federal Motor Carrier safety rules.
- Experience working and communicating with mechanics for necessary repairs on the truck.
- Willingness to complete other driving duties as assigned; including water trucks in support of our timberland firefighting efforts.
- Demonstrate pride in keeping keep truck clean and in good working order. This requires dedicated hours as a part of the weekly schedule for inspecting, maintaining, and washing your truck. In partnership with our shop, we do 100% of our truck maintenance and upkeep. This requires extra time outside of driving every week.

- **A proven ability and desire to be a team player.** It is essential that the selected applicant works well with others and maintains a positive attitude. Lone Rock works as a cohesive unit to provide the best service to the overall company, not just the trucking department or individual.
- A working understanding or the ability to learn weight configurations, permit requirements, and load securement procedures as they apply to short and long log configurations.
