General Job Description:

Lone Rock Resources is looking for a highly motivated, innovative forester to join our Coastal Operations Team, based in Myrtle Point, OR. This person's primary responsibility will be field based activities in support of sustainably growing and harvesting timber on approximately 50,000 acres of company managed land located in Coos, Curry, and Western Douglas Counties. This job reports directly to the Coastal Harvest Manager and works as an integral part of the coastal area team.

Job duties include:

- Harvest administration, including unit layout
- Preliminary forest road and harvest landing layout
- Map creation and electronic file storage
- Communication and relationships with neighbors and government agencies
- Reforestation activities, including: planting inspection, herbicide application and contract administration, and stand exams
- Prescribed burning and wildland firefighting as needed
- SFI documentation and participation in audits
- Land acquisition appraisals
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications include:

- Excited about sustainably growing and harvesting trees
- Willingness to live in Coos county
- Ability to work independently on steep ground for long periods of time in adverse weather conditions. Successful candidate will spend a majority of their time in the field.
- General knowledge of Microsoft operating systems (Word, Excel, Outlook, Access). GIS experience is preferred.
- An Associate's Degree in an area of forestry or at least 2-years of experience of forestry field work. A Bachelor's Degree is preferred but not required. Qualified applicants with an expected graduation date on or before June 2021 are encouraged to apply
